




## VERTICAL RACK SIX INSTALLATION

When installing the two-piece Vertical Rack to a ModWall Panel, be sure to space the Upper Shelf and Lower Shelf to fit your rifles' length and most appropriate orientation. Failure to install correctly may lead to firearm damage. Check instructions on back for a visual representation.




# FOR BEST RESULTS

Insure your Vertical Rack is in contact with the proper areas of your firearm. The Upper Shelf must allow rifles to easily pass thru the designated opening from the bottom. Some rifles may need to be orientated with the mags facing away from the wall for a secure installation.

Assemble the Vertical Rack Six as depicted with the provided hardware.


**NOTE:** There are two variants of triangles. Three pre-drilled for a 90-degree orientation & four for a 45-degree orientation.




## CAUTION!

Due to weight, extra screws may be required along used panel slots to insure the panel does not get pulled away from the wall and potentially cause the Lower Shelf to fall out.

**DIRECT-TO-WALL** The 6 attachment holes can be used to fasten the entire rack to a wall directly into 16-inch on-center studs. To attach Lower Shelf directly to wall, the Lower Shelf face plate with 8 fasteners will need to be removed from the triangles to access wall attachment holes. Use those holes to drive drywall screws into studs and reattach the face plate.
