


VERTICAL RACK 6 INSTALLATION

When installing the two-piece Vertical Rack to a ModWall Panel, be sure to space the Upper Shelf and Lower Shelf to fit your rifles' length and most appropriate orientation. Failure to install correctly may lead to firearm damage. Check instructions on back for a visual representation.




Assemble the Vertical Rack Six as depicted with the provided hardware.

NOTE: There are two variants of triangles. Two pre-drilled for a 90-degree orientation & four pre-drilled for a 45-degree orientation.


Both parts (Upper Shelf & Lower Shelf) have fasteners 16 inches apart to easily attach them unto a standard ModWall Panel.

FOR BEST RESULTS

Insure your firearm is in contact with the proper areas of your Vertical Rack. The Upper Shelf must allow rifles to easily pass thru the designated opening from the bottom. Some rifles may need to be orientated with the mags facing away from the wall for a secure installation.



CAUTION!

Due to weight, extra screws may be required along used panel slots to insure the panel does not get pulled away from the wall and potentially cause the Lower Shelf to fall out.
